Foraging, Fishing & Farming: Eating Ecologically *20th Annual* Living Environment Institute & Teachers on the Estuary (T.O.T.E.)



Join us this summer as we spend three days learning from professionals in the field as we explore different ways people interact and use their land. We will be joined by experts from NYSDEC, NYSDOH, school staff and administrators as well as locals working in the field of ecological and sustainable farming practices. Participants will visit WILD Hudson Valley, an agroforestry farm, to learn about foraging and native farming. Another field trip will head to the Radix Ecological Sustainability Center, which promotes ecological literacy and environmental stewardship.
